According to the inscription **was moved from inside the city to Sagredo on the wishes of the Venetians**

**Sagredo chose this site** outside the city walls and next to the sea, as the church was dedicated to sailors

**The modern church of Aghios Nikolaos must be more recent and was consecrated in 1836.**

**The church is in the basilica style** roof, known as 'the heavens', which is common to Italian style churches
