When the Turks conquered the city in 1453, Christian churches were forbidden to operate within the walls of the

Somewhere between 1772 and 1780, the Sultan granted Aghia Sophia the right to hold Christian ser

From then on, it was the only Christian church inside the walls that was allowed to hold services

After the liberation of Nauplia in 1826, Aghia Sophia was renovated and dedicated by the Provost Marshal of Nauplion
