Construction on the Church of Aghios Spyridon was completed in 1702, during the time of the second Venetian occupation of the island. It was funded by the Naupliot brothers, who were prominent in the city at the time.



It was here, outside this church, that on 27th September 1821, the first battle of the Revolt of 1821 was fought. The church was damaged during the battle, but it has since been restored.
